### WHAT YOU NEED

Ask an adult for an empty egg box and a pen.



### LEARN

Ask an adult, look in a book, go online.

**How many different animals can you think of that lay eggs?**

(Hen, turtle, ant, butterfly, salmon...)

**Name one mammal, one reptile and one bird which lay eggs.**

(Platypus, grass snake, blackbird)

**What do the scientific terms oviparous and viviparous mean?**

(Lays eggs, gives birth to live young)



### DO

**1** Write the following descriptive words on the lid of your egg box, placing each one above a hole: hard, soft, round, long, shiny, green.

Go on a scavenger hunt! Find things to match each of the words written on your egg box. Once you've found one put it in the correct hole. Keep going until your box is full. You might find more than one of each or do some things fit in more than one hole?

**2** Choose your own descriptive word and write it on the bottom of the egg box. Then go on another scavenger hunt and fill all the holes with items that match your word. Give the egg box to someone in your household and see if they can guess your word! Send a picture to a friend or relative, can they guess it too?

### MAKE

Choose 6 descriptive words and create your own egg box scavenger hunt for someone in your household. We'd love to see what you've done, why not share a picture of your full egg boxes on social media.
