## WHAT YOU NEED

Paper or card (ask an adult for  
some from the recycling bin)  
Scissors (ask an adult first)  
A pencil and glue

## LEARN

1. How many birds can you see? Count how many you see on your walk or spend 15 minutes looking out of a window.
2. Can you name them? (Try the RSPB website for help)
3. Choose 3 different birds and find out the following:
  - What colour eggs does it lay?
  - What does it like to eat?
  - What is its UK conservation status (green, amber or red)?



## MAKE SOMEONE LAUGH

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## MAKE

Draw around your hand with a pencil on to a piece of paper or card then carefully cut out the shape (ask an adult for help). Do the same with your other hand.

Lay the two hand cut-outs side by side and overlap the thumbs in the middle (this will be your bird's head). Stick the hands on to a piece of paper.

Go for a walk either outside or around your home and look for things to decorate your bird or cut out shapes. You will need a beak, two legs, two eyes, feathers....

Decorate your bird.  
Don't forget to name it!
