WHAT YOU NEED
2 x loo roll inserts, glue,
string, pens.

Learn about animal scavengers and test your scavenging skills.

LEARN

1. As well as hunting food, some animals are scavengers which means they eat animals and plants which are already dead. You need good sight, smell & hearing senses to be a successful scavenger.
2. Can you name an animal scavenger?
3. Scavengers are very important because they help to 'clear up' by eating dead animals and plants.

MAKE

A pair of binoculars. Ask an adult to pierce a hole near the end of each loo roll insert. Next glue the inserts together, making sure the 2 holes are on the outside. Once the glue has dried, thread some string through the holes to make a loop to go around your neck. Decorate your binoculars, will they be bright or camouflaged colours?

Answers 2. Buzzard, brown rat, crab, great white shark, vulture, hyena ...
